READING: Joshua 4:1-9 and 16-24

IN

Introduction

- Before the group encourage people to bring a photo of something from the past that brings back happy (or sad) memories. Share these memories at the start of the session.
- Think how our memories of the past can help us in the future?

In today's teaching we are finding out what Joshua called the tribes to do when they passed to the other side of the Jordan.

UP

Explore

A memorial is a means of intentionally remembering something. Name some different kinds of memorials in today's world that you can think of as a group.

READ Josh 4:1-9 and 16-24

- In Joshua 4 v 2 and 3 what did Joshua get people to do to remember this important moment?
- Look at v 9 in different translations and see what you find out.
- Why did God want them to have these memorials?
- Can you think of other memorials in the Old and New Testament? What do they each remind us of? Why does God want us to have memorials?
- Read v 21-24 and think about why these memorials were important and who they were for.
- Can you think of any personal memorials in your life?

OUT

Respond

Think and pray about how we can use what God has done in our lives in the past to be a memorial to encourage us, our children and others in faith. Think of 1 thing that you can share with someone this week about a time when God was at work in your life.
