### **UP: Introduction**

**READ: Nehemiah 12 v 27-43**

What are the hallmarks of this celebration? Suggestions: togetherness, joy/rejoicing, purification, thankfulness.

What does Christian joy look like?

How does being thankful affect our hearts and our minds?

How can we celebrate and be thankful in challenging times in our lives? What impact can that have on us?

John 2v19 - Reflect on Jesus and the gospel - the resurrection being the ultimate rebuilding of the temple and the gospel being a constant source of joy and thankfulness for us.
