READ: Gal 4:4-7

In this passage Paul is talking to a church. This community had come to believe in Jesus Christ, and many had come from different faith backgrounds. For some this would have meant being 'separated' from their human families, they would have given up so much to be followers of Jesus. However, there were influencers that were trying to convince them to adopt Jewish practices in order to truly belong....

- Why do you think Paul uses the language of families not fans or spectators in his letters when addressing the church?
- What is significant for you in your own family (past or present?)
- How does this principle of being family encourage you as you think about the church you are part of?
- How does this principle of being family challenge you as you think about the church you are part of?
