#### **UP: Introduction**

- What's the best thing about getting together with family or friends? What are some of your favourites?
- What purpose do gatherings of family or friends serve?

### **IN: Explore**

READ: Leviticus 23

- This chapter explains the principal feasts that YHWH instructed the Israeiltes to keep. What words or patterns jump out at you?
- Two of the words in Hebrew that are repeated are אָרֶבְיָ (miqra) and מֹוֹעֵד (moed).

  They can be translated as 'reading' and 'appointed times'. In light of this, what might be the purpose of a 'sacred assembly'?
- YHWH ordained festivals as times of thanksgiving, holiness, rest and fellowship.
   How does that transfer to Sunday worship as Christians?
- What difference might it make if more 'festivals' were practiced in our church community?

## **OUT: Impact**

- If festivals, celebrations and gatherings are about retelling God's story, worshipping God and celebrating God's goodness, what might flow out of them?
- How can we make all of our 'sacred assemblies' about the above, whilst introducing new people to ancient practices?
